671 BC	Esarhaddon captures Memphis in surprise attack and deports "heir apparent" Ushanukhuru (Necho II)	594 BC	
670 BC	Mentuemhet appointed ruler of Thebes Necho II returns to Egypt as Assyrian vassal Psamtik II reigns alongside Necho I/Taharqa and campaigns in Nubia	593 BC
